Go Green Expo coming to Philly this April

The Go Green Expo makes its second appearance to the Philadelphia area April 16-18, 2010. This year's event comes to the Greater Philadelphia Expo Center in Oaks. The Expo is open for business-to-business purposes on Friday, April 16 before opening to the general public Saturday from 10am to 6pm and Sunday from 10am to 5pm. A \$10 ticket (\$5 for senior citizens and students and free for children under 12) gets attendees access to both days.

The Go Green Expo will show over 200 booths featuring companies that demonstrate any and all aspects of sustainable practice, from renewable energy providers to organic foods, from chemical free cosmetics to sustainable design firms, from alternative fuel vehicles to skateboards made from recycled materials. Many exhibitors will also display a wide array of green building materials including solar panels, replacement windows, high efficiency insulation, alternative heating and cooling solutions, and much more.

In addition to product booths, patrons can also look forward to speeches and seminars by industry leaders, a green job expo, hands-on activities and demonstrations, a green marketplace, and free samples. And the Go Green Expo will practice what it preaches, using alternative energies, recycled and recyclable materials, and paperless ticketing.
